PMUY in J&K

- On 28.09.2016, Chief Minister, J&K and Union Minister of State for Petroleum & Natural Gas, formally launched Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) in the state of Jammu & Kashmir.
- The scheme provides free LPG connections to the women from BPL households.
- The scheme was launched by the Chief Minister along with the Union Minister of State for Petroleum and Natural Gas at two separate functions organized at Jammu and Srinagar on same day.
- Also present on the occasion were Union Minister of State for development of North Eastern Region, PMO, Personnel Public Grievances & Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitender Singh, Deputy Chief Minister, Dr Nirmal Singh, Minister for Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs (FS & CA), Chowdhary Zulfkar Ali, MP's, Members of State Council of Ministers and Legislators.
- More than 3500 persons attended the function at Jammu and more than 2500 attended the function at Srinagar.
- The number of beneficiaries earmarked for release of Free LPG Connections under PMUY is as per the Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC) 2011 data.
- In Jammu & Kashmir as per SECC-2011 data, the number of Women Beneficiaries to whom Free LPG Connections under PMUY are to be released is 667344.
- Within a month of launch of the PMUY in J&K about 1 Lac Free LPG Connections were released in J&K under PMUY to eligible beneficiaries.
- Till end of Financial Year 2016-17, about 2.66 Lac Free LPG Connections were released in J&K under PMUY to eligible beneficiaries. Out of 667344 beneficiaries till March 2017 about 3.78 Lac beneficiaries had been approached, out of which 2.95 Lacs had been cleared through KYC de-duplication process.
- Till now out of 667344 beneficiaries, 4.98 Lac have been approached out of which 3.72 Lac have been cleared through KYC de-duplication process and 3.60 Lac connections have been released. (Latest Status District Wise J&K is attached)
- On All India basis, the %age of Connections released in various status with respect to the beneficiaries available under SECC-2011 data as on 15.01.2018 is attached herewith.
