1. The qualification / genuineness of the Welfare Institutions in relevance to the standing orders / instructions of the Government is certified and it may be ensured that the said institutions are not covered under any other scheme like SC / ST / OBC Hostels.
2. The Welfare Institutions other than Government run must be registered under the provisions of the Registration of Societies Act.
3. The allotted foodgrains shall be lifted by the concerned Institutions only after depositing the cost of foodgrains at BPL rates within the validity period of 50 days for the respective months.
4. The number of inmates in the Welfare Institutions is certified and each inmate is provided 15 Kg per month.
5. All other necessary codal formalities are fulfilled.
6. The monthly progress report shall be furnished by 10th of next month..
