- (ii) Distribution of the allocated foodgrains shall be made on pro rata basis to the eligible BPL families in monthly installments from April - September 2015 during the financial year 2015-16.
- (iii) The Cost Price of the said allocation shall be met out of the funds already released under normal budget. However the expenditure incurred on this account shall be reflected in the Revised Estimates for the Year 2015-16.
